GENERAL NEWS

Social Studies Fair: A packet of information has been distributed to students about the Social Studies Fair. Please review the information and project ideas carefully. Provide the necessary guidance with your child to complete the project. The preschool and K-2 students will complete a group project in the classroom. Completed projects will be brought to school by February 26 and on display in the fellowship hall for viewing after church services on February 28 and March 7.

Forensics Video: The forensics video has been edited and posted online. You can find the links for the corresponding classrooms on Class Dojo.

MAP Testing: Winter MAP testing will take place January 18-22 for students in grades 1-8. Generally, the tests are taken in the morning. It is preferred that appointments be avoided during these days. Please also encourage your child to do their best on these tests. As the test name implies, it is our goal to see academic growth from our previous testing in the fall. Reports & scores will be shared with families when available.

Tuition Update: The Board of Education has been discussing a few tuition related items. First, the Board has approved a \$100 tuition increase for all K-8 students for the 2021-2022 school year. The board has also added a \$50 discount for families with two or more children enrolled. Therefore, the tuition for the first child of a member family will be \$1,200 and any additional child will be \$1,150. Additionally, the board has a committee planning a tuition assistance program that will be announced in connection with the new school year pre-enrollment information.

TADS Payments: Families paying by semester are reminded that your 2nd installment for tuition through TADS will be coming out this month.
