GENERAL NEWS

MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Testing: Students have worked very hard during the recent MAP tests and have done their best. The results of MAP tests will be reviewed by the teachers and also shared with you in the form of a parent report and discussed at Parent/Teacher Conferences in November.
